MCCOOK COUNTY CONSERVATION DISTRICT - PROJECT ASSISTANCE REQUEST The Board reviewed a project assistance request letter from the McCook County Conservation District. The District is requesting cost share assistance to help promote tree planting in the county. Fred Butzke discussed their tree planting program and ideas for utilizing any granted cost share funding.

The VBWDD has granted tree planting cost share money in both Clay and Turner counties in the past with good results.

Following discussion, Director Chadima moved to grant up to \$5,000 to the McCook County Conservation District for tree planting cost share in 2024. Seconded by Director Davey. Motion passed unanimously.

2024 TAX LEVY

- 1. Mill Levy The total property valuation for the District this year is \$4,419,117,563. The tax revenue proposed for 2024 is \$130,126. This results in a rounded mill levy of .029.
- 2. Resolution #24-01 This resolution authorizes a tax to be placed on all real property in Turner, Clay and McCook counties for the purposes of financing the VBWDD budget for 2024.

Following review, Director Iverson moved to approve Resolution #24-01. Seconded by Director Chadima. Motion passed unanimously.

SWAN LAKE ASSOCIATION

The Swan Lake Association informed the Board that there are potential changes to the scope of the study to be conducted by DGR Engineering. The VBWDD had previously committed to financial aid to be used towards the study.

Due to the potential changes in the cost and scope of the study, Director Davey moved to table the approval of the grant agreement with the Swan Lake Association. Seconded by Director Chadima. Motion passed unanimously.

PROJECT UPDATES

The Board discussed ongoing projects of interest to the District that included the City of Centerville, Clay Rural Water System and Town of Chancellor.

OTHER BUSINESS

- 1. <u>Expansion Discussion</u> Manager Preheim informed the Board that he and EDWDD Manager Jay Gilbertson have begun discussions with legislators in regards to upcoming legislation with the hope of finalizing the District boundary expansion.

- 3. <u>River Appreciation Day</u> Director Chadima updated the Board on this event that was recently held at Clay County Park.
